All persons entering the facility are admitted only subject to the following Ground Rules –

1. The Campsite will be open from 2pm on Sunday 3rd August 2025, and will close at 2pm on Monday August 11th 2025. Should you need to arrive earlier please contact the organisers.
2. Check ins are from 2 – 7pm, checkout is by 12pm (midday)
3. €50 Deposit on booking will be refunded on checkout in cash should all the rules have been followed.
4. There will be 24hr stewards and assistance available if required.
5. Drinking water points will be provided.
6. Hot showers are available on-site.
7. No trading or selling of any kind is allowed in the campsite.
8. Large vans will need to purchase a campervan ticket. No camping will be permitted in the Car Park in cars or on the grass.
9. Sleeping in vehicles in the car park is prohibited.
10. The use of amplified music is not permitted in the Campsite. Please respect the local community and keep noise to a minimum.
11. Quiet time will apply after midnight. In general camping areas, quiet time will apply after 12am. Patrons are asked to respect others. Causing excessive noise may result in patrons being evicted from the site.
12. No animals, other than guide or hearing dogs, are permitted on site.
13. Caravan/Campervan vehicles will receive an identification tag for vehicle on arrival
14. Pizza and Drink will be available for purchase at the WHBTC Bar Area.
15. **Children aged 18 years and under must be accompanied at all times by an adult, limited to a maximum of two children per adult.**
16. Passes are non-transferable. Should you wish to change attendees' names post purchase, please contact organisers prior to event.
17. Tickets must be valid and presented in full. You are responsible for your ticket prior to entering the event.

18. Organisers will not issue duplicate tickets for lost or stolen tickets or passes.
19. Any item(s), reasonably considered for use as a weapon, which may cause danger, offence or disruption to any other person, will be confiscated.
20. Any person carrying illegal items or carrying out illegal activity will be reported to the An Garda Síochána and refused entry.
21. The organiser reserves the right to evict a customer and/or refuse admission, without a refund
22. Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and will lead to eviction. Please act responsibly.
23. This is a working sports facility and the organisers request that you respect the land on site and use pre-determined walkways. Attendees must remain within the site confines and keep away from any fenced areas.
24. Please keep all signed emergency routes/exits free and unobstructed. Please comply with stewards if asked to reposition your Caravan/Campervan/Tent. We thank you in advance for your co-operation.
25. The use of drones or similar equipment for any reason is strictly forbidden onsite without written permission from the organiser.
26. The organiser is unable to accept any liability for personal or property damages, losses (including confiscations) or injuries sustained at this event – other than caused as a result of our negligence. Any personal property brought to the event is at your own risk.
27. Prosecution may occur if you cause damage to the campsite venue, the campsite infrastructure, or cause harm to any other person at the campsite.
28. There will be general waste bins and recycling points provided on site. We encourage you to segregate waste as instructed.
29. Anyone involved with starting a fire will be evicted from site.
30. Under 18's are not permitted to bring alcohol on site or to purchase alcohol at the campsite.
31. Please note It is illegal for an over 18 to purchase alcohol on the behalf of under 18s.
32. The climbing of walls, fences, statues, staging or other structures in the camping area is forbidden.
33. All patrons must familiarise themselves with the emergency exits and pay due attention to the safety announcements made regularly.
34. In the event of an emergency, the patrons must leave the area of the emergency and proceed in a calm and orderly fashion to the assembly point in the Car Park.
35. Awnings on Campervans and Caravans are allowed to extend past your marked boundary
36. The campsite opens @ 2.00 pm Sunday 3rd August and closes @ 12.00 pm Monday 11th August 2025.
37. This is a strictly **NO GLASS** site, please only bring plastic and canned goods.
38. Campervans, once parked, must remain in place for the duration of your booking.

39. Once caravans have parked the accompanying vehicle must use the designated car parking area. Cars cannot park beside caravans.
40. Caravan Bookings include one Car Parking space for the vehicle towing the Caravan. All other bookings do not include a Car Parking Space unless specified.
41. Plot locations will be allocated to patrons in advance, by emailed correspondence. Patrons will be given the opportunity to camp alongside friends, family or anyone else that they wish to be alongside, subject to availability. Every effort will be made to accommodate any such requests.
